

## The SGM results are in!



Please find above the results of the SGM vote. The count was completed on Tuesday the 6th October and this is the first notice of the voting outcome to the membership. There were a total of 919 counted votes. There were some 60 additional votes that were not counted for reasons that included:

Voter not found on the spreadsheet of members current on the date of vote closure;

(i) Student pilot member - a temporary membership type and therefore not eligible for voting;

(ii) Duplicity in voting - A formula here was used to decide on where members had placed more than one vote

the SGM2 vote then there was a breach of one vote per member and the vote was not counted.

\* If there was a SGM1 vote and an SGM2 vote received from a member then the SGM2 vote took precedence and counted as per the SGM2 ballot sent in by the member. This was taken so as to accept the error in the closure date and reason for the SGM2 ballot being employed.

(iii) A number of votes were presented without either identification of the member or with identification but no ticks in any of the motion boxes. In either case these were not counted simply because there was nothing to count.

(iv) A further number of votes were received where the person making the vote could not be properly identified - that is to say that they did not have their name, signature and HGFA number included on the form. If any of these criteria were missing then the vote was not counted.

The counting of votes was overseen by Hamish Barker and (on day one of the count) Chris Vonderwall - I thank them both for their assistance in counting the votes, without them we would not have gotten the job done as quickly.
