Attendees can look forward to some relaxed and chilled coastal flying (weather permitting), getting to know other sky-loving women (guaranteed), talks and workshops on instruments and forecasting and any other topic the group wants to explore. The ticket price includes 2 nights accommodation at Sydney Lakeside Holiday Park (shared cabins) and all meals from **Friday evening to Sunday lunchtime**.





The format of this Fly-In differs a little from the others in the series, in that it is a 2-day fly-in rather than a 3-day fly-in. This means it should be easier to fit in to your usual schedule and a little cheaper but the same amount of awesome company!
