

Canungra - Notice to all CHGC Members and visitors,

The CHGC Committee recommend that all members cease all flying activity until further notice.

Due to evolving Government restrictions regarding the COVID-19 outbreak and to minimise the risk of further spreading of the virus we feel that its in everyone's best interest to cease our activities which will also reduce the risk of adding to the emergency services.

While we don't recommend flying activities to continue, we appreciate that livelihoods and freedoms are at risk, therefore, we are not specifically closing CHGC sites down, but are implementing the following rules:

No XC flying is to occur from club sites.

Pilots are to launch and land in corresponding sites, that is, launch from Beechmont and land at Beechmont (top or bottom landing). Launch from Tamborine, land at Tamborine bomb out.

Landing in shared public locations such as Moriarty Park or where there is risk of landing in private land residence or public shared locations is forbidden until further notice.

Ride sharing and hitching should cease immediately.

All pilots choosing to fly are to maintain the highest standard of social distancing recommendations and respect for other members and the public.

Pilots should not be increasing risk levels by flying beyond their skill or attempting manoeuvres outside of their abilities (such as face landings etc)

This will remain in place until specific law or direction from higher authorities, such as SAFA or government, specify that we are to cease operations.

Further guidance will be released as directions are passed onto the club.
